
#### South Africa

The Kruger National Park is the largest nature reserve in South Africa. Well-known world wide for its diversity of wildlife as well as the big five. We are offering you the opportunity to join us on the Lebombo 4X4 Eco Trail and take part in an experience of a lifetime.

Starting in the south, we travel all along the eastern boundary, the Lebombo Mountains, and eventually end up in the most northern corner of the Park. Approximately 600km is covered with your 4 nights and 5-day stay in the Park. Traveling in off-road vehicles, we mostly make use of dirt roads and stay in the bush just as the pioneers have done in the early days.

This trail is exclusive and is not open to the public, so most of the time it will just be us and the wild life, around us. A minimum of 6 and a maximum of 12 guests are allowed on the trail.

#### Vehicles.



Double cab off-road vehicles with aircons are used. Each vehicle carries three guests and the driver. We stop along the road at points of interest. Here an experienced guide will explain interesting facts, varying from animal behavior to historical information. Yes, at many of these points you are allowed to exit the vehicle on approval of the guide.

#### Accommodation.

We stay in the bush in tented camps and or rooftop tents, specially erected for the trail. Each tent accommodates two people, stretchers and or mattresses with bedding are supplied. Take note that, as this is a bush experience, the toilet facilities are primitive but functional and decent.

We make use of the shower and bath facilities in the official campsites of the Park, when close by.



#### Meals.

Supper is the main meal of the day. Early mornings start of with coffee and rusks and a brunch later on. There is no set menu but most food is South African "braai meals" and food is prepared by the guides.

Special diets can be catered for if needed.

We also make stops at the official shops of the Park.

#### Experience.

The most exciting experience is sitting around the camp fire at night, listening to the African bush calls, lions roaring, elephants passing by, jackals calling and who knows what else will the African bush surprise you with, all this while sharing the days highlights with one another.
